

Drugs 21-40 Side Effects

Medication (Brand/Generic Name)	Potential Side Effects
Advil (Ibuprofen)	Nausea - Heartburn - Stomach pain - Dizziness - Headache - Rash - Increased risk of gastrointestinal bleeding and ulcers
Ativan (Lorazepam) Klonopin (Clonazepam)	Drowsiness - Sedation - Dizziness - Weakness - Confusion - Respiratory depression (especially with high doses) - Dependency and withdrawal symptoms with long-term use
Celexa (Citalopram) Lexapro (Escitalopram) Prozac (Fluoxetine)	Nausea - Dry mouth - Drowsiness - Insomnia - Increased sweating - Sexual dysfunction (such as decreased libido or difficulty achieving orgasm) - Weight changes
Cipro (Ciprofloxacin)	Nausea - Diarrhea - Abdominal pain - Headache - Dizziness - Photosensitivity (increased sensitivity to sunlight) - Risk of tendon rupture, particularly in older adults
Coumadin (Warfarin)	Bleeding (risk of internal bleeding and hemorrhage) - Easy bruising - Blood in urine or stool - Nausea - Vomiting - Diarrhea - Purple toes syndrome (rare)
Dyrenium (Triamterene)	Increased urination - Dizziness - Weakness - Fatigue - Gastrointestinal upset - Elevated blood potassium levels (hyperkalemia) - Photosensitivity
Flexeril (Cyclobenzaprine)	Drowsiness - Dry mouth - Dizziness - Blurred vision - Constipation - Confusion - Muscle weakness
Flonase (Fluticasone)	Nasal irritation - Nosebleeds - Headache - Sore throat - Cough - Nasal fungal infections (rare)
Keflex (Cephalexin)	Nausea - Diarrhea - Abdominal pain - Rash - Allergic reactions - Yeast infection (oral or vaginal)
Neurontin (Gabapentin)	Dizziness - Drowsiness - Fatigue - Peripheral edema (swelling in the extremities) - Ataxia (loss of coordination) - Weight gain - Tremors
Plavix (Clopidogrel)	Bleeding (risk of internal bleeding and hemorrhage) - Easy bruising - Rash - Itching - Abdominal pain - Diarrhea - Headache
Pravachol (Pravastatin)	Muscle pain or weakness (myopathy) - Liver problems - Digestive issues (such as nausea, diarrhea, or constipation) - Increased blood sugar levels (especially in individuals with diabetes)
Proventil (Albuterol)	Tremor - Nervousness - Headache - Dizziness - Palpitations - Increased heart rate - Dry mouth
Septra (Sulfamethoxazole/Trimet hoprim)	Nausea - Vomiting - Diarrhea - Headache - Rash - Allergic reactions - Increased risk of sunburn
Singulair (Montelukast)	Headache - Nausea - Diarrhea - Abdominal pain - Dizziness - Fatigue - Mood or behavioral changes (rare)
Sterapred (Prednisone)	Increased appetite - Weight gain - Insomnia - Mood swings - Acne - Increased susceptibility to infections - Osteoporosis with long-term use
Ultram (Tramadol)	Drowsiness - Nausea - Dizziness - Headache - Constipation - Sweating - Itching or rash
