Actos (Pioglitazone)	Weight gain - Edema (fluid retention) - Hypoglycemia (low blood sugar) when used with insulin or sulfonylureas - Upper respiratory tract infection - Headache - Muscle pain
Catapres (Clonidine)	Drowsiness - Dry mouth - Constipation - Fatigue - Headache - Dizziness - Rebound hypertension (if stopped suddenly)
Celebrex (Celecoxib)	Stomach pain - Heartburn - Nausea - Diarrhea - Gas - Headache - Dizziness - Edema (fluid retention)
Flomax (Tamsulosin)	Dizziness - Abnormal ejaculation (including decreased semen production) - Headache - Rhinitis (runny or stuffy nose) - Weakness - Back pain
Lantus (Insulin glargine)	Hypoglycemia (low blood sugar) - Injection site reactions (such as redness, pain, or itching) - Weight gain - Lipodystrophy (changes in fat distribution) at injection sites - Allergic reactions (rare)
Levaquin (Levofloxacin)	Nausea - Diarrhea - Headache - Dizziness - Insomnia - Rash - Photosensitivity (increased sensitivity to sunlight) - Tendon rupture (rare)
Medrol (Methylprednisolone)	Increased appetite - Fluid retention - Weight gain - Insomnia - Mood changes - Increased susceptibility to infections - Osteoporosis (with long-term use)
Oxycontin (Oxycodone)	Constipation - Nausea - Vomiting - Dizziness - Drowsiness - Itching - Sweating - Respiratory depression (especially with high doses)
Phenergan (Promethazine)	Drowsiness - Dizziness - Blurred vision - Dry mouth - Constipation - Urinary retention - Confusion - Respiratory depression (with high doses or in combination with other CNS depressants)
Prevacid (Lansoprazole)	Headache - Nausea - Diarrhea - Abdominal pain - Constipation - Dry mouth - Vitamin B12 deficiency (with long-term use)
Edarbi (Azilsartan)	Dizziness - Fatigue - Diarrhea - Hypotension (low blood pressure) - Hyperkalemia (high potassium levels) - Renal impairment (rare)
Seroquel (Quetiapine)	Sedation - Dizziness - Dry mouth - Weight gain - Constipation - Increased cholesterol levels - Orthostatic hypotension (low blood pressure upon standing)
Soma (Carisoprodol)	Drowsiness - Dizziness - Headache - Agitation - Tremor - Blurred vision - Upset stomach
Tricor (Fenofibrate)	Stomach pain - Diarrhea - Nausea - Headache - Dizziness - Increased liver enzymes (transaminases) - Gallstones (rare)
Tylenol 3 (Acetaminophen/Codeine)	Drowsiness - Constipation - Nausea - Vomiting - Dizziness - Headache - Dry mouth - Respiratory depression (especially with high doses)
Vasotec (Enalapril)	Dry Cough - Dizziness - Hypotension (low blood pressure) - Hyperkalemia (high potassium levels) - Angioedema (swelling of the face, lips, throat, or tongue)

Viagra (Sildenafil)	Headache - Flushing - Dyspepsia (indigestion) - Nasal congestion - Impaired vision (including blurred vision, changes in color vision) - Priapism (prolonged, painful erection) (rare)
Focalin (Dexmethylphenidate)	Insomnia - Decreased appetite - Weight loss - Nervousness - Headache - Stomach pain - Increased heart rate - Hypertension (high blood pressure)
Yaz (Drospirenone/Ethinyl estradiol)	Nausea - Breast tenderness - Headache - Weight changes - Mood changes - Spotting or breakthrough bleeding - Changes in menstrual cycle
Zyloprim (Allopurinol)	Rash - Nausea - Diarrhea - Drowsiness - Headache - Liver toxicity (rare) - Increased gout attacks during initial treatment
